Photorealism is a genre of art that includes painting, drawing and other graphic media, in which an artist studies a photograph and then attempts to reproduce the image as realistically as possible. In this painting workshop, students will study subject matter with superior clarity and focus on detail, value, color, and forms, to re-create a photograph on canvas using oil paints.
