Basic Handbuilding

In our 8 weeks together, we will focus on pottery hand building skills of pinch, coil, and slab to create a variety of pieces that will be fired and glazed for participants to take home and use. In addition to hand building, glazing and other basic studio skills will be covered. Each lesson will begin with a time of demonstration of techniques and suggestions of forms to create for those who are interested. Participants will have the option to make the same forms or work on their own creations. The class will be flexible depending on participant interest and skill level. Individual instruction will be given as needed and as time allows. Examples of classes will include: Create pinch pots for sculpture, bowls, and cups. Make a form using coils, Slab built dinnerware. Using a variety of methods together to make forms, add texture and other embellishments. The goal of the class is to teach basic hand building in a creative, fun environment. The pottery you create will be food, dishwasher, and microwave appropriate.
